Lead Service Line Inventory Survey

What is a “Water Service Line”?

It is the water line that connects your house to the main water line in the street.

The part between the main water line and the water meter is the “Town” side, and the part between the water meter and the house is the “Customer” side.

What is the Lead Service Line Inventory?

The Town of Chase City is creating an inventory, or a list of all of the water service lines that might contain lead. This inventory will be used to make a plan for how lead service lines will be replaced by non-lead lines in the future.

What is the Lead Service Line Inventory Survey?

This survey helps the Town gather information about the water service lines. It also asks your permission to inspect your water service line on the customer side, if needed. (This is free.)

Who is helping with the project?

Southside Planning District Commission (SPDC) is assisting the town with the Lead Service Line Inventory. You may see SPDC staff in town looking in and around water meters at these service lines.

Please check all of the following that apply:

I give the Town of Chase City staff permission to verify my water service line type by digging next to my water meter, on my side of the meter. This would most likely involve digging an 18" deep hole beside the meter, if it is accessible (not under pavement, concrete, landscaping, etc.)

I have a basement or an easily accessible crawlspace where you can easily see the incoming water service line, and I would like to make an appointment to have you verify this line.

I am not interested in the Town of Chase City verifying my water service line, either at my side of the water meter nor in a basement or crawlspace. I understand that the town-owned portion of the water service line may still be verified.

I think I may have a lead water service line. (We will contact you for more information.)
